ESL Tutor job description & requirements

- Build a relationship with a new ESL international student through tutoring sessions
- Meet 5 days a week – one hour per day
- Coordinate tutoring issues with ESL instructors
- Participate in social functions as available and desired with international students
- Assist student in other transitional issues
- Attend ESL tutor meetings
- Assist with referrals and transition to use of academic support center

- Exhibit friendliness and patience to people from other cultures
- Strong communication skills
