- Enthusiasm for Northwestern, hospitable, positive attitude, integrity, dependable, servant leadership, commitment to teamwork and a desire to serve and engage new students.
- Not involved in fall sports, CMT, RA, Student Activities leadership, or Athletic Training.
- As an o-staffer you will lead a group of students for orientation weekend that includes leading discussions and getting to know your group members.
- You will also be responsible for helping organize different activities or events depending on which committee you are on.
- Completed application submitted no later than 5:00 PM Friday, March 4. Submit completed application to the Student Life Office.
