Who can apply: All sophomore, junior, and senior BSN students

Description and Basis for Award

- 1 Five scholarships will be granted each year.
- 2 All sophomore, junior, and senior BSN students may apply (Exclusions: Those students receiving tuition remission).
- 3 Recipient must have a CGPA \geq 3.0.
- 4 Recipients will be selected by the Department of Nursing using the following criteria:
