### Orange City Area Health System Foundation Nursing Scholarship

#### **Summary**

This scholarship was established to encourage students to pursue a career in rural healthcare.

Who can apply: Current sophomore or junior level (traditional or non-traditional) BSN students.

(An application must be submitted each year to be considered for renewal.

Renewals are not guaranteed.)

#### Description and Basis for Award

- 1. A scholarship will be granted each year to a sophomore or junior level nursing student who has a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher. All scholarship awards are contingent on funding.
- 2. Preference to a nursing student who intends to work in a rural health care setting. A brief essay on the student's interest in the rural healthcare setting and how such a setting provides opportunities to practice Shalom-based nursing.
- 3. This scholarship is renewable for a second year, provided the student earns a CGPA  $\geq$  3.0. An application must be submitted for the second year to be considered for renewal. (An application must be submitted each year to be considered for renewal. Renewals are not guaranteed.)
- 4. Recipients will be selected by the Department of Nursing after conferring with the Financial Aid Office.

Deadline: January 15

## Accountability to Donor

Each year the Advancement Office will inform the donor(s) as to the current year scholarship recipients. Those receiving the scholarship will be encouraged to write a brief note of introduction and appreciation to the donor. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend the annual scholarship luncheon held on campus each fall.
